“Increase In Oropharyngeal Cancer Due To HPV”
1 CEU

Course Description: This course will discuss the importance of knowledge about the Human Papilloma Virus. It will also stress the need for vaccinations to prevent cancer and rationale for the age to recommend the vaccination. It will also identify various HPV-associated oral lesions and their risk for HPV and cancer.

Upon Completion of this course, participants should:

- Describe the burden of HPV disease.
- Define the importance of HPV vaccination for cancer prevention.
- Explain the rationale for vaccinating youth at ages 11 and 12.
- List the recommendations for HPV vaccine for girls and to boys.
- Provide useful and compelling information about HPV vaccine to parents to aid in making the decision to vaccinate.
- Identify common HPV-associated oral and oropharyngeal lesions.
- Differentiate the oral lesions that contain low-risk HPV from high risk HPV.
- Discuss the differences between oral and oropharyngeal squamous cell carcinoma.

Speaker: Lynne Williams, MD, PhD



Dr. Lynne Williams is the Executive Director of the Southwest PA Area Health Education Center. The Center is running a grant out of the CDC to help improve HPV vaccination rates by educating providers. Over the past couple of years, Dr. Williams has been mainly speaking mainly with medical providers. Now that it has been noted that the rate of oropharyngeal cancer due to HPV is rising, and has surpassed cervical cancer, she is focusing on outreaching to dental providers. Dr. Williams has also begun working with the Univ. of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine .

“Radiation Safety Certification - Refresher”
2 CEU’s

Course Description: The use of radiography for medical diagnosis is a key component to the oral health professional. Although the dental practice exposes patients to some of the lowest amounts of medical radiation, it is important to stay current on the safety and best practices to protect the patient and the provider. This course will review the science and safety of radiology in accordance to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. This course will also provide you with the most current policies and procedures of radiation exposure and practice, and proper disclaimer information to post in the healthcare setting.

Upon Completion of this course, participants should:

- Understand radiation science.
- Review x-ray imaging techniques and safe practices
- Know how to properly maintain a quality assurance (QA) program, safety plans, and documentation.
- Review regulations and policies per the guidelines set by the PA DEP
